RESEARCH GRANT FOR DOCTORATE STUDENTS

ELIGIBILITY OF RESEARCH PROPOSAL

1. New research proposal or Ongoing research activity as part of a research umbrella and/or stand alone study
2. Meet the objectives and criteria of DII
3. Commit to produce a publishable manuscript for International journal within 6 months post final report
4. Grantees must obtain ethical clearance from credible institution

CONDITION OF THE GRANT

1. The awarded length is up to one year. Multi years research can be considered
2. The grantee must sign contract
3. Commit to release data to become public domain three years after last financial payment
4. The grantees must add the following sentence in the Acknowledgment section of any publication: "This study is fully/partly funded by Danone Institute Indonesia".
5. The use of legal software is a must

PRE-REQUISITE

1. The applicant should be a registered doctorate student of universities in Indonesia
2. The applicant should be the Principal Investigator (PI) for the research work
3. The team should consist of PI, and at least one Advisor and one research assistant (preferably student)

PUBLICATION GRANT FOR INTERNATIONAL JOURNAL

The grant includes cost for publication and reward. The cost of publication will be in accordance to the publication rate from the journal. The amount of the reward for the Grantee will be Rp 5,000,000 per published manuscript.

PRE-REQUISITE

1. The applicant is an Indonesian citizen
2. The manuscript is in line with DII's mission and themes
3. The applicant must be the first author of the manuscript
4. The applicant received an acceptance letter from a peer-reviewed international journal
5. The manuscript is not yet published by the journal

In the case that cost of publication has not yet paid by the applicant, DII will transfer the fund directly to the journal. In the case that the applicant already paid the Cost of publication, DII will reimburse this cost.

RESEARCH GRANT FOR INSTITUTIONS

The Eligibility of research proposal and Condition of the grant follow the terms set for doctorate research.

PRE-REQUISITE

1. The research institution should be based in Indonesia
2. The mission and objectives of the institution are in accordance to the missions and objectives of DII
3. The applicant is the head of the research institution or holds an equivalent position. The PI and research team may not necessarily come from the applicant's institution
